1. Thank you for your letter at Reference A, which details the arrangements for the above event taking place at Javelin Barracks, Elmpt Station, Germany on 19 April 2008. BA (G) Staff Clearance has been granted and is;

2. You are advised that all competitors should carry a valid ID card, passport and European Health Insurance Card (EHIC). The organiser is to satisfy themselves the Safety System of Training¹ is in place and that the security of the party is considered and Host Nation customs observed.

3. The payment of compensation to service personnel (including TA) injured when playing sport is a complex area. Even whilst on duty there are occasions when compensation to service personnel and/or third party is not admissible. Accordingly, it is advised that all personnel consider having their own personal accident and personal liability insurance cover. A number of insurance companies are listed in the Defence Discount Directory. Additionally you are to ensure that adequate medical cover is available at the event and that all members of the party have adequate medical cover.

4. Please note the use of the Representational Sport Travel Vote 1E1 1403 is **NOT** admissible for travel to this event.

5. Units based outside of BF(G) are to apply individually to the Army Sport Control Board in Aldershot for authority to travel and then apply to the BA(G) Sport Board for their Staff Clearance.

¹ The Safe System of Training identifies instructor, teachers, coaches and officials who are competent by virtue of qualifications, currency, experience and maturity.
